Subject: Non allowing TA/DA to the participants from offshore, participating in "Khelo ONGC-WOU 2024-25".

Respected Sir,

This has reference to the office circular no. MUM/WOU/RO/sports/2024-25 dated 03.09.2024 regarding Mumbai Regional Sports Tournament/Meet "Khelo ONGC-WOU 2024-25" where participation of our employees from offshore and base offices have been invited. Please find attached the copy of the circular for your perusal.

It has been mentioned on page no. 2 at point no. 3 that "The participating players shall not be allowed any TA/DA for participation in the games."

Your authority must be aware that employees including **"Executives"** and **"Non-Executives"** are performing their duty in offshore travelling across PAN India. Prior to this, the tournament was known as **"Offshore Trophy"** Now it has been renamed as **"Khelo ONGC-WOU 2024-25"**. Almost 60% of employees are working in offshore, till last year TA/DA was sanctioned to the employees participating in the games.

Last 10 years employees have been recruited in Mumbai Region from all over Maharashtra. Presently employees doing On/Off duty in offshore are given Hotel accommodation in Mumbai one day before their scheduled duty. Now where the employees participating in Games will stay in Mumbai. Our guest house in Santacruz has been closed almost 5 years now.

All these events we can celebrate or organize because of major share of offshore production of ONGC, and we are not providing facilities to offshore employees is disgusting. At least employees working in offshore should have been extended the facility of TA/DA to participate in games. No one from offshore will participate spending money from their pocket which may kindly be noted.

We hope that the Tournament/Meet "Khelo ONGC-WOU 2024-25" is for all ONGCians. Functions arranged in Mumbai cannot be attended by employees working in offshore. It happened when we had celebrated 50 years of "Mumbai High." Depriving offshore employees by not sanctioning them TA/DA is painful and is an unmindful decision.

Your esteemed authority is requested to kindly look into the matter and offshore employees participating in games be sanctioned TA/DA. Hope to take a favourable decision in the matter at the earliest as there is widespread unrest among employees working in offshore.

- 1. The events shall be as far as possible organized on weekends with emphasis on not to disturb the normal working.
- 2. The participating teams shall not be allowed any facilities /time during office hours for practice etc.
- 3. The participating players shall not be allowed any TA/DA for participation in the games.
- 4. The players are expected to carry their individual equipment/team Kit for elated Sports like Cricket kit, Badminton and TT rackets, Tennis Rackets etc. as the same shall not be provided by the organizers. However consumables like, seam ball, shuttles, TT and Tennis balls etc. shall be made available by the game organizers.
- 5. Only regular employees are eligible to participate.
- In-charge HR/ER designated for conducting the trials shall decide the modalities of conducting such trials and select a team/players. On completion of the process the details of the selected team/players shall be communicated to Sports Coordinator.
- 7. Active sportspersons recruited under sports quota shall not participate in any of the events.
- De-Categorized Sportspersons above 50 years of age recruited under sports quota can participate in his/her own game/sports.
- 9. Participants born on or before 31.12.1979 shall only be eligible to participate in above 45 years category.
- 10. The team numbers are inclusive of Managers/trainers/ any other support staff the teams may have.
- 11. The Unit game coordinators are requested to provide the sizes of kits i.r.o participating players well in advance.
- 12. One Player can participate in maximum of 2 events only.
