Sub: Request to re-empanel the following hospitals in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and near vicinity to facilitate the continuation of ongoing treatment for the ONGC employees and their beneficiaries.

Respected Sir,

Your esteemed authority has issued **Circular no: WOU/RO/Circular/25/48 dated 03.04.2025** regarding discontinuation of panel hospitals. As a result our regular employees, retired employees and their families are facing many problems, especially **those having prolonged illness like Cancer, Kidney diseases, heart diseases, Diabetes etc. The Role of superspecialists in above illnesses plays an important role** and it is difficult to find or change to a new set of doctors or hospitals set up in the middle of ongoing treatment, especially in reference to the long term illnesses as stated above. Following are the hospitals are discontinued presently:

- Palvi Hospital, Uran
- Fortis Hiranandani Hospital, Vashi
- Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital, Koparkhairane
- Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital, Andheri
- Fortis Hospital Ltd, Kalyan
- Holy Cross Hospital, Kalyan
- Icon Hospital, Dombivali
- Lifeline Hospital, Panvel

The above hospitals have been empaneled with ONGC for a long time. The sudden de-empanelment of the above hospitals in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai & their vicinity area is causing the beneficiaries to face a lot of hardships with reference to the treatment of their routine long-term illnesses, like cancer, heart disease, Kidney diseases, diabetes, hypertension, arthritis etc. & day to day minor illnesses like fever, cold, stomach upset etc. We would like to highlight a few important points with reference to the need for re-empanelment of these hospitals.

Palvi Hospital in the Uran area

ONGC Onshore Plant is in the Coastal city of Uran, in Raigad District. Most of the secondary and tertiary healthcare facilities are in Navi Mumbai, which are roughly 30-40 km away from Uran.

There have been cases of minor and major accidents and injuries in the plant in the past. Previously any accidents/ injuries (Burn injuries, falls with fractures and wounds), were referred to Palvi Hospital for First Aid (which is within a kilometer's distance from ONGC plant). After initial First Aid and treatment at **Palvi Hospital**, we referred the patients to higher centers.

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In the absence of a referral center in the vicinity of the Plant, it will be difficult to give timely first aid to the injured employees.

For employees, their dependents and retirees are residing in Uran city. There is no other ONGC empanelled hospital within the vicinity of Uran city. The beneficiaries, at present must travel to Navi Mumbai or Mumbai to undergo any treatment for any minor or major illnesses or emergencies, adding the cost of travel to their treatment cost.

Similarly, there are many ONGC employees and retirees are residing in **Navi Mumbai, in Vashi, Nerul, Belapur, Ulwe, Kharghar and Panvel**. There are very few good, empaneled hospitals in Navi Mumbai region.

With two hospitals, namely **Fortis Hospital in Vashi and Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital in Koparkhairane** are de-paneled, how many beneficiaries are in distress in dilemma, with regard to continuance of the treatment of their dependents in these hospitals for long term illnesses like Diabetes, Cardiac problems, cancer etc.

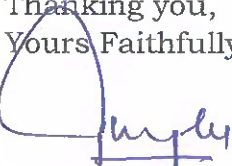
With just one or two hospitals are left in the ONGC panel in Navi Mumbai and there are very limited options of doctors and hospitals to choose for various health problems.

Also, these few empaneled hospitals are likely to exercise their monopoly in the absence of any competition which is going to be adversely affect the beneficiaries.

Similarly the case of ONGC employees and retired employees residing in **Kalyan - Dombivli** area with their families. Also there is no other ONGC empaneled hospital within the vicinity of Kalyan Dombivli city. The Beneficiaries, at present must travel to Thane or Mumbai to undergo the treatment for any minor or major illnesses or emergencies. Empanelling the above hospitals in Kalyan Dombivli will facilitate our employees in emergencies.

Your esteemed authority is requested to re-empanel the above hospitals at the earliest by resolving their technical issues or they may be given extensions till fresh empanelment or agreements takes place, so that beneficiaries may get some relief in continuing their ongoing healthcare services from current health providers (hospitals or doctors).
