Sub: Diploma in Pharmacy to be treated as Q-2.

Respected Sir,

This has reference to our letter dated 10.01.2005, on the above subject, please find enclosure for your perusal and kind consideration.

It is also pertinent to mention, Mr. Rajesh Singh, who was denied E-0 Status w.e.f. January 2004, quoting his qualification was not in sequence to be treated as Q-2. In view of this, it was explained earlier by individuals representations, which is self-explanatory.

We once again quote, that the said qualification in reference to R&P-1980, Diploma in Pharmacy was treated as Q-3, beyond that B. Pharma was treated as Q-1. Now, after long deliberation, Diploma in Pharmacy is considered as Q-2 by Appeals Committee, then the academic qualification is no more an issue for pre-condition.

In the case of Mr. Rajesh Singh, while joining ONGC he was having 10 + 2 + Diploma. The mode of acquiring the said qualification is explained in his representation, which is very clear that there is no reason why he should be denied promotion to E-0 w.e.f. January 2004, considering his qualification as Q-2.

We request your esteemed authority till such time a decision is taken towards his qualification as Q-2, a provisional sanction may be given so that he may be considered for interview which is being held on 03.08.2006.
